FREE VIEWING:

To promote tennis in the Cayman Islands, this year free viewing sessions will be provided to both juniors and adults. The 2011 Legends Tennis had over 1,250 Cayman juniors viewing the event for free.

CAYMAN WILDCARDS:

Cayman's best players will again get a chance to be on court with the best in the world, with wildcards offered to the best Cayman coaches, players and amateurs. A new "Cayman Qualifying" day has been added for an exciting night of Cayman players battling it out for the wildcard positions.

Junior Cayman Events

The 2012 Legends Tennis will offer an extensive range of benefits for Cayman juniors. The "Junior Legends" allows Cayman's best to play in the curtain-raiser matches, so that our top juniors experience playing on a stadium court in front of a large crowd, something that isn't normally possible in the Cayman Islands.

Cayman schools will receive free equipment, coordinated through the Tennis Federation of the Cayman Islands, and the visiting pros will offer tennis workshops to encourage more local youths to participate in the sport.

National Body

The Tennis Federation of the Cayman Islands sanctions the event. The tournament helps the Tennis Federation achieve their goal of helping more community schools implement a grassroots tennis program.

2010


Three former World #1s battled out for the 2010 championship with Stefan Edberg, Marat Safin and Jim Courier all vying for the Cayman trophy.

2011


2011 saw the first female players joining the event, with mixed doubles.
